Caller ID Fact and Fiction

Recently, a number of our clients have asked questions about Caller ID Service. So, this seems like a good time to clarify the facts from fiction. Caller ID Service requires a team effort to work. The effort involves two players: your phone company and phone equipment.

Inbound Caller ID

Inbound Caller ID is a subscriber-based service. If your business uses analog phone lines, a monthly fee is paid for each line that requires the service. Fees range from \$3.50 to \$5.00 monthly depending upon the responsible phone company. Those who use PRI phone services know Caller ID (with Name) is a standard feature. Depending upon your physical location, T1 phone services *may* deliver Caller ID Service. In these cases, Caller ID with Name is an additional fee.

The other part of the team is your phone equipment. The age and technology of your phone system impacts Caller ID availability. Some phones only carry one line of display information. So, there's no sense wasting money or time hoping for the name of the party to come up in the phone. It won't work. The phone number is all you will see on that older system. If you're certain your phones have at least a two-line display and the full Caller ID information is not showing, it's time to check with your equipment vendor. Sometimes the issue can be resolved simply by having the equipment vendor and the phone company check the settings.

Acronym Corner

Acronyms and their meanings.

ANI

Automatic Number Identification

Is a software system allowing phone companies to identify the billed phone number making a call. This service makes call detail billing possible.

CLASS

Custom Local Area Signaling Services

A variety of enhanced phone services packaged on analog lines; the service allows phone companies to transmit information about the caller (like Caller ID and Call Trace).

CLID

Calling Line Identification

The digital equivalent of CLASS or, analog-based Caller ID Service which is used on PRI and modern SS7 switches.

LDN

Listed Directory Number is the specific number a phone company assigns for sending outbound Caller ID. Even though a business may have several trunk groups with different phone number assignments, only one number, the LRN, can be delivered to other customers on the network.

Caller ID may not work on all phone networks all the time. There are several factors affecting its availability. Depending upon the age and capability of your neighborhood Central Office, Caller ID may or may not be available. RAM has several sources available for checking Caller ID availability. We will be more than happy to check for service in your area.

Outbound Caller ID

The same limitations affect Outbound Caller information as well. It's important to remember there is no, single phone network in the United States. Hundred of networks share phone information from state to state.
